What Are We Learning?

WEDNESDAY: The boys and girls practiced for a fire drill. For Large Group Time, we sang the song, "Twinkle Twinkle Little Star," and did some hand movements as we were singing.

THURSDAY: During Small Group Time, each table explored one center in the classroom. They learned the name of the center, talked about the rules, talked about how the shelves are labeled to help them know where to return the toys and materials when they are finished playing with them, and then they got to play with the toys and materials in that center. For Large Group Time, we sang the song, "Itsy Bitsy Spider," and did some hand movements as we were singing.

FRIDAY: For Small Group Time, each table explored in another center in the classroom. We reviewed the center name, rules, where to put the materials when we are finished playing with them, and then the boys and girls were given time to play with the toys and materials in the center. For Large Group Time, the boys and girls learned the "Shake" song. They came up with ideas as to how we could move our bodies.

What Are We Learning?

TUESDAY: The boys and girls explored in a new center. They played with the toys and materials in that center and then cleaned up by using the picture labels when it was time to put the toys and materials away. For Large Group Time, we talked about personal space. A hula hoop was placed on the floor for each child to show them their personal space. Each child stood inside the hula hoop on the floor while moving their bodies to the song, "Swing and Sway."

WEDNESDAY: During Small Group Time, each table explored one more new center in the classroom. They played with the toys and materials in that center and then cleaned up by using the picture labels when it was time to put the toys and materials away. For Large Group Time, we reviewed what personal space means. Each child found a hula hoop on the floor to stand inside of for their personal space. They sang the song and did the actions to the music, "Wheels on the Bus."

THURSDAY: For Small Group Time, each table explored the last two centers in our classroom. They played with the toys and materials in those two centers and then cleaned up by using the picture labels when it was time to put the toys and materials away. The children explored with scarves during Large Group Time. After some exploration time, we listened to the Scarf songs on the "Body Bingo" CD and we moved our scarves like the song told us to.
