What Are We Learning?

MONDAY: Today during Small Group Time, we talked about when we wash our hands, why we wash our hands, and how we wash our hands. Afterwards, each child was given some "Glow Germs" on their hands. The teacher shined a special flashlight on their hands to show them where all of the "germs" were. Each child took turns washing their hands. The teacher checked their hands again with the special flashlight to see if they washed off the germs. Most of the children were asked to wash their hands a second time because lots of germs were still found on the tops of their hands where they had not scrubbed them.

TUESDAY: The boys and girls were introduced to finger painting for Small Group Time. They came up with an idea of what they wanted to finger paint on their finger paint paper, they chose the colors of paint they wanted to use, and with their pointer finger they moved the paint around on their paper. Two children chose songs from our classroom songbook for us to sing and move our bodies.
