Tax Assistance

Voluntary Income Tax Assistance (VITA) is a free tax preparation service for low income individuals, individuals with a disability and the elderly. This program generally runs from the beginning of February through April 15th. Returns are electronically filed. This is a basic service and cannot deal with complicated returns such as self-employment, business and complicated deductions. Let's talk for a second about the hardest job in the entire world; parenting. It's the one job that doesn't come with a manual or handbook. Our children, especially our young ones, can be so confusing. As a mother of two boys (6 and 1 and a half), I can personally tell you that parenting is not easy. One day my $1\frac{1}{2}$ year old will eat macaroni and cheese; and the next time I make it he won't touch it. For months my 6 year old won't have an accident in the middle of the night; the next week he will have one for 3 days in a row.

Even though being a parent isn't easy, it can be the most rewarding job out there. Your children look up to you. Whatever you do, they do. You are their model, their number one and most important educator. But to be present and be the best role model for your children, you need to take care of yourself.
