Keeping Kids safe and healthy during the Winter months

1. Host Friends and Family, not viruses

Don't let viral respiratory illnesses like the flu, RSV, and COVID-19 put a stop to your family's fun. The best way to ensure your child's immune system can fight off infection, is to be sure they are up to date on any recommended vaccines or vaccine boosters. Always remember the simple but effective way to reduce the spread of germs is proper hand hygiene!

2. Keep an eye on safety

Be sure to keep safety in mind especially with young children in the home during the winter months! Be sure to keep any electrical outlets covered, along with keeping cords up and out of reach of little hands! Ensure batteries of all sizes are placed out of reach as well.

3. Age appropriate toys

While out shopping, be sure to check labels for recommended age use. Often toys for older children have smaller pieces and should be kept out of reach of those younger than them to prevent choking hazards. Be sure to read all label warnings and instructions while putting any toys together.


4. Food and drink


