## Screen Time Limits by Age

For Young Children

A <u>screen</u> is: a TV, a phone, an iPad or tablet, a computer, a game console or any other device or toy that has a screen.

0-18 months

## No screens!



24 months

- $\rightarrow$  No more than 30 minutes a day
- → Educational content that is fun and engaging.
- → Talk about what your child is watching.

-2 years

- $\rightarrow$  No more than 60 minutes a day.
- → Watch together and talk about it.
- → Live video-chatting is OK and can help young children learn new words.

For All Kids

No screens!

- $\rightarrow$  At the dinner table
- → In the bedroom
- → One hour before bedtime



<u>Remember</u>, when you put a screen in front of a child, please watch with them and encourage conversation while you both watch. Too much screen time without talking impacts their speech and language development.




