Activity: Oobleck

We will be making oobleck today. We are going to experiment with it and see if a we can make a ball. What will happen when we open our hands?

Child Goal: I can tell what I think will happen.

School Readiness Goal: SCI 2. Child engages in scientific talk.

Thursday March 7

Activity: Let's go fishing

We will go fishing with fishing pools that have a magnet on the end instead of a hook. After we catch all of the fish, we will count the fish by color and see how many of each we caught.

Child Goal: I can count things and tell how many there are.
