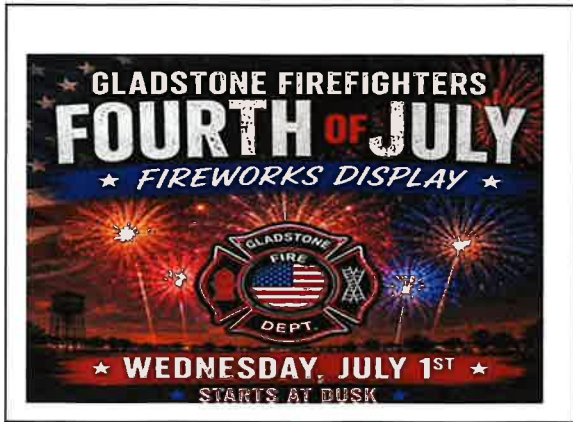

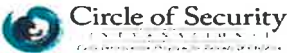

# HOW TO CLEAN A CAR SEAT THE RIGHT WAY!



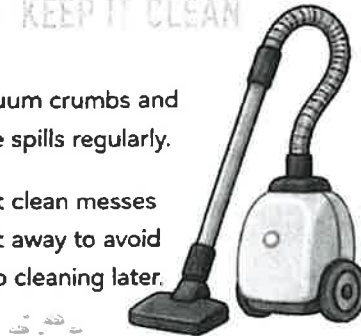
## 1 READ THE INSTRUCTIONS

- Always follow the car seat manufacturer's cleaning instructions.
- Avoid damaging warning labels or stickers.



## 2 KEEP IT CLEAN

- Vacuum crumbs and wipe spills regularly.
- Spot clean messes right away to avoid deep cleaning later.



## 3 WASH CAREFULLY

- Use mild soap and water only.
- Do not use bleach, harsh cleaners, or heat.



### CAR SEAT PAD



- Check if it can be machine washed or must be hand washed.
- Air dry unless the instructions allow dryer use.



### HARNESSES STRAPS



- Most harnesses should NOT be soaked.
- Wipe with mild soap and water, then air dry.



### CAR SEAT SHELL



- Clean with mild soap and water.
- Dry with a soft cloth.

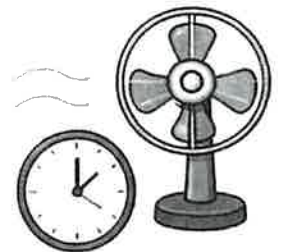
## 4 CLEAN THE BUCKLE



- Remove the buckle from the seat.
- Rinse the buckle with warm water only.
- Do not soak the buckle strap or use soap, lubricants, or chemicals.
- Air dry completely.
- Test the buckle until both sides click properly.

## 5 ALLOW TIME TO DRY

- Let all parts dry completely before using the seat.
- Drying may take several hours or overnight.



## 6 REASSEMBLE CORRECTLY

- Follow the instruction manual carefully.
- Take photos before taking the seat apart to help with reassembly.
- Make sure harness straps are not twisted.
- Check that the harness and buckle are securely installed.



## 7 USE EXTRA PRODUCTS CAREFULLY



- Only use seat protectors or accessories approved by the car seat manufacturer.
- Read and follow the car seat manufacturer's instructions.
- Contact the manufacturer if you are unsure.

## 8 NEED REPLACEMENT PARTS?

- If parts cannot be cleaned well, contact the manufacturer for replacement parts.
- Have the model number and manufacture date ready.
